Situated on 3,500 acres of lush ranch land outside of Park City, Utah, The Lodge at Blue Sky invites guests to slow down and forge meaningful connections with the land, animals and people that call Blue Sky home.

Blue Sky is a place of soul and spirit, located 40 minutes from Salt Lake City International Airport.

LOCATION

The Lodge at Blue Sky is situated on 3,500 acre ranch outside of Park City, Utah, surrounded by the Wasatch and Uintas mountain ranges. Conveniently located within a 40-minute drive of Salt Lake City International Airport, Blue Sky is remote yet easily accessible.

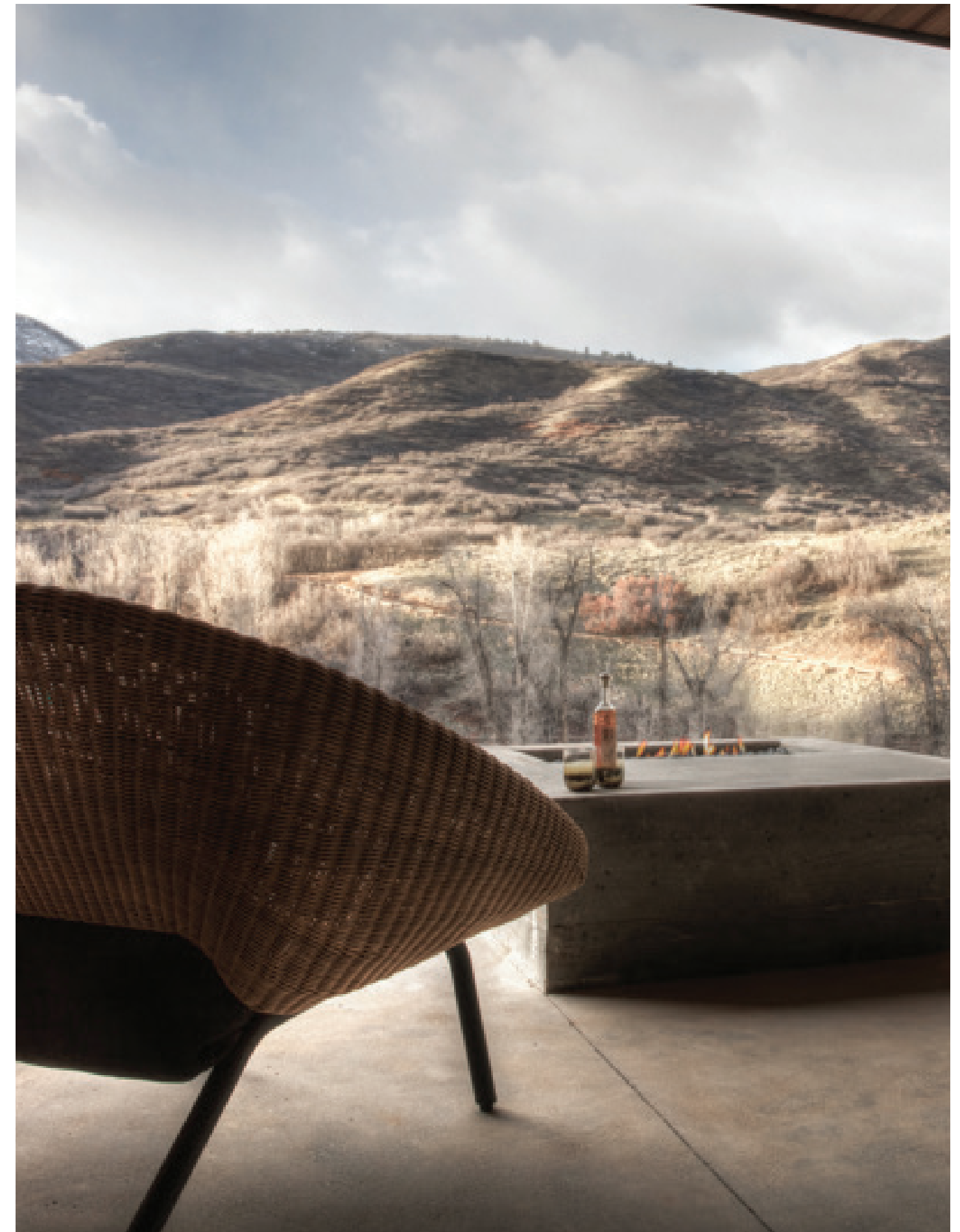

THE SPIRIT OF PLAY

HORSEBACK RIDING

Tailored to riders of all ages and levels of experience, Blue Sky's trail rides allow guests to journey over varied terrain and enjoy panoramic views.

NATURAL HORSEMANSHIP LESSONS

Experience an introduction to the philosophy and practice of Natural Horsemanship, where guests will learn to speak the language of the horse through non-verbal queues.

FLY FISHING

Local streams include the Weber River and Provo River, the latter of which is a Blue Ribbon stream, a rare accreditation given to certain bodies of water for exceptional water clarity as well as abundance and diversity of fish. Fly fishing is also available on miles of private Blue Sky waters. Guests will receive fly-tying instruction and casting lessons from their expert guides. All gear is provided.

SPORTING CLAYS

The sporting clays course presents guests with different target scenarios, mimicking the unpredictable movements and patterns of birds. Finish with a flurry at the 5-stand shooting pavilion.

HIKING

With 3,500 acres of pristine Utah wilderness on our doorstep, hiking opportunities abound at Blue Sky. Grab a map and hiking poles for self-guided exploration, or book a guided expedition to learn about the fascinating local flora, fauna, geology and history of the region.

MOUNTAIN BIKING

A mountain bike instructor will teach guests how to maneuver and navigate Blue Sky's single-track trails, or guests can opt to borrow a mountain bike and trail maps for self-guided exploration.

OUTDOOR YOGA + MEDITATION

Take your practice beyond the studio and into a remote outdoor setting with inspiring mountain views. Outdoor yoga and guided meditation can be combined with hiking, mountain biking, or horseback riding to reach your outdoor location and is great for individuals, couples and families alike.

VERTICAL VINYASA

Yoga in silks which utilizes bright silk cloths suspended from the branches of trees, deep in an alpine forest.



LITTLE VAQUEROS

Blue Sky's younger guests (ages 4-12) will enjoy daily themed excursions tailored to their age group, including horsemanship lessons, riding, fishing, wildlife education, treasure hunts and farm days. Younger guests are encouraged to respectfully interact with the special horses, cows, chickens, and bees that call Blue Sky home, and to get reacquainted with nature.

ALPINE EXHILARATION

BLUE SKY SKI LOUNGE

Blue Sky is a 20-minute drive from Park City Mountain Resort. The Blue Sky Ski Lounge is conveniently located at the base of the mountain, a resplendent ski-in/ski-out base for guests to use during the daytime. Keep your gear there, enjoy a restorative hot drink, a nourishing snack, request tune-ups, grab some hand warmers, or have the Ski Lounge attendant book a spa treatment for your return to Blue Sky. Regular complimentary shuttles will run between Blue Sky and the Ski Lounge. After an exhilarating day on the mountain, Blue Sky guests are invited to escape the crowds and return to our 3,500 acre sanctuary.

NO LINES

All lift tickets will be provided at the resort, offering guests the opportunity to bypass long lineups in the village. Less waiting, more enjoying.

RENTALS

The Blue Sky team will ask for your ski/snowboard preferences prior to your arrival, and have an outfitter come right to the hotel to do your fitting fireside, glass of wine optional. Once you make your selections, your boots and gear will be taken to the Ski Lounge which you'll find waiting for you the next day, boots warmed and skis or snowboard waxed.

HELI-SKIING & SNOWBOARDING

For advanced skiers and snowboarders, Blue Sky offers backcountry skiing on site, as well a full heli-ski operation in partnership with Cloudveil. The helicopter lands right on Blue Sky's property and, within a 10-minute flight, takes you to over 1 million acres of untouched terrain in the Uintas range. Most groups will average 15,000-20,000 vertical feet per day.

APRÈS SKI AT HIGH WEST

We have a High West distillery on site which produces world-class whiskeys. You can enjoy a bracing beverage after a full day of skiing, or do a tour and tasting to learn the finer points of distillation from grain to glass.

WINTER ACTIVITIES

Blue Sky is set on 3,500 acres which serves as our own personal playground. In addition to skiing and snowboarding, guests can enjoy cross country skiing, snow shoeing, snow cat tours, horse riding, sporting clays, dog sledding, yoga, and whiskey tastings & tours of the impressive High West Distillery. End an invigorating day with a bracing beverage by the fire.





EDGE SPA

Built on a dramatic precipice this iconic Auberge Spa invites guests to enjoy a variety of indulgent treatments and mindfulness pursuits. Water is a key component to the design of this sanctuary: The five luxurious treatment rooms overlook a gorge with a murmuring creek at the bottom, which connects to both the infinity and soaking pools. Treatments are locally inspired and feature products that utilize natural, bloom-to-bottle ingredients. Mindfulness experiences include indoor and outdoor yoga, family yoga, guided meditation, and vertical vinyasa: aerial yoga which uses large swaths of silk suspended from tree branches in a secluded forest.

REDEFINED WESTERN CUISINE

THE LODGE AT BLUE SKY

The Dining Room at Blue Sky is located in the Sky Lodge and features elevated mountain cuisine which celebrates organic meats, fish and vegetables, many of which are locally sourced or harvested on site. The Bar + Lounge offer guests a chic, serene environment in which to relax, enjoy the impressive views and savor inventive craft cocktails, High West Whiskey flights or light gourmet snacks.

THE PRIVATE DINING ROOM

This 750-square foot room is an intimate space for private functions, cocktail gatherings or intimate dinners.

WINE ROOM

This 670-square foot space houses an impressive wine collection from around the world and can also be used for private functions.





THE HIGH WEST DISTILLERY

Blue Sky invites guests to learn about the whiskey making process from grain- milling and mashing through distilling and aging. Learn how some of the world's most storied beverages are made from rye, wheat, oat and malt in massive copper stills imported from Scotland. Cap off the tour with educational whiskey tastings. Guests can also enjoy inspired Western country cuisine at High West's restaurant, The Refectory, amid glorious mountain views.

THE ARENA
